







Half-day Innovation Session

Two-day Strategic Session

Award Timeline

Half-Day, Full-Day, Two-Day Sessions Completed within 12-months of award

One Year Capacity Builder
Launched within 3-months of award

Evaluation Criteria

- Grantmaking preference will be given to organizations that operate in the cities where Dupaco maintains a physical branch office.
- Organizational readiness and capacity to participate in innovation sessions
- Level of impact the session would have on the organization and their service to individuals and the community
- Organization's stated needs fit well with the proposed process and expected outcomes of session.
- Quality of the application (clearly stated, feasible, and appropriately focused detailing how the session would impact their organization)


